FINAL JUDGMENT FOR DEFENDANTS

This case was tried before the Court on June 6, 2022 and the Court, having considered the testimony and other evidence, heard argument of counsel and considered the applicable case law, makes the following findings:

1. At the close of Plaintiff's case, Defendants Lewis D. Thibeault and Linda Thibeault moved for an involuntary dismissal of the action. The Court deferred consideration of motions and the defense rested. Upon the defense resting its case, the Court heard argument on Defendants' Motion for Involuntary Dismissal. Viewing the evidence in the light most favorable to the Plaintiff, the Court finds that the Plaintiff failed to prove a prima facie case to reestablish the lost line of credit agreement.

2. Accordingly, Defendants' Motion for Involuntary Dismissal is hereby **GRANTED** and this case is hereby **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.

3. **FINAL JUDGMENT** is hereby entered in favor of Defendants Lewis D. Thibeault and Linda Thibeault. Plaintiff shall take nothing by this action and the Defendants shall go hence without day.

4. The Court reserves jurisdiction for a determination as to entitlement to attorney's fees and costs.
